



### DID YOU KNOW?

In 1964, the Grapevine Conference Committee recommended "that all Grapevine Committee members henceforth be kept informed during the year on all Grapevine matters of Conference importance".

In 1969, the Grapevine Conference Committee recommended: AA World Services, Inc. and the AA Grapevine, Inc., with the primary purpose of the Fellowship foremost in mind, study their efforts in each other's behalf and extend to each other the fullest cooperation in making the Fellowship aware of the tools of AA".

In 1985, the Grapevine Conference Committee recommended: that, since each issue of the Grapevine cannot go through the Conference-approval process, the Conference recognizes the AA Grapevine as an international journal of Alcoholics Anonymous".
